

## Cleaning instructions upon departure

Since you share the accommodation with other roommates, you have a shared responsibility to leave the accommodation in the right condition following the instructions below.

#### **Personal Items**

You are not allowed to leave any personal items in your accommodation or shared space. This includes, pillow, extra mattresses, blankets, food and hygiene products, etc. The only items you are allowed to leave are functioning internet cables and routers.

### Bedroom/livingroom

- Sweep and mop the floor, skirting boards, sockets, etc. No dust/dirt should remain.
- Clean all the doors in the accommodation (the front, top and the frame).
- Clean all the furniture in the accommodation (move the furniture in order to clean under and behind
- Clean cabinets and wardrobes (the inside, outside and the top).
- Clean the radiators (the front, under and behind).
- Clean the windows (the glass on all sides, frames and the window sill).
- Clean lampshades and replace nonfunctional light bulbs.
- Replace the battery for nonfunctional smoke alarms.

### **Bathroom**

- Sweep and mop the floor, skirting boards, sockets, etc. No dust/dirt should remain.
- Clean the wall/tile in order to remove dirt and grease.
- Clean toilet and sink (the inside, the front and the back). Don't forget to clean the pipes under the sink and behind the toilet.
- Remove the cover of shower drain and remove the dirt which stops the water flow.
- Clean the mirror.
- Clean shower door or bathtub (if included in the accommodation).
- Clean shower curtain (if included in the accommodation).
- Clean the ventilation shaft and remove dirt which stops the air flow.

#### Kitchen

- Remove food and items from your personal cabinet. Clean cabinet and shelves, inside, outside and on top.
- Remove food from your part of the fridge/freezer and clean it in all its parts.
- Clean the wall/tile in order to remove dirt and grease
- Sweep and mop the floor, skirting boards, sockets, etc
- Clean the top of the stove including the hotplates
- Clean the front and the inside of the oven and the included baking trays, oven racks and handles
- Clean the kitchen fan remove the filter and clean in order to remove dirt and grease
- Clean sink, the drain and workbench
- Clean the ventilation shaft and remove dirt which stops the air flow

# SUITABLE CLEANING AGENTS/DETERGENT TO USE:



For cleaning inside the oven. (Not for microwave oven.)



For cleaning and polishing windows and mirrors.





For mopping the floors.



For cleaning inside the toilet.



For washing up all cutlery, plates and kitchen implements. For cleaning the removable filter in the fan above the stove.



For all surfaces in the kitchen and in the bathroom, such as inside the refrigerator, walls in the bathroom and top of the stove.
